- 2. Students who belongs to category 2, 3, 4 One student can participate in a maximum of five single events and two common group events (Total 7 events). Out of 5 single items only three can be stage item and two non-stage item.
- 3. Participation in the following common group items shall be irrespective of category (Only for Category 2, 3 and 4) Selection of participants for common group event is the discretion of house captains.

  - Group Song (7 participants)
  - > Patriotic Song (7 participants)
  - ➤ Mime-Boys (7 participants)
  - Group Dance-Girls (7 participants)
- **4.** Even if there is only one entry for an item, the competition will be conducted and grade, prize and points will be awarded as per the decision of the committee.
- 5. The selection for Group Events is done solely at the discretion of the house-in charges. For further clarifications regarding the group events, students may contact their respective House Master or House Mistress.
- **6.** The items mentioned as 'Non-Sahodaya' will not have participation in Sahodaya Kalotsav.
- 7. Once registered for an event, participation is mandatory.
- **8.** Students have to ensure that the online registration is done only ONCE.
- **9.** The participants have to adhere to the rules of the Kalotsav.
- 10. Prizes will be distributed only during common school assembly.
- 11. Only the Participants who secured **First position with an A** grade will be selected for the Kollam Sahodaya Arts fest.

### **CLARIFICATION ON RULES FOR THE EVENTS.**

### 1. Group Song: (Time allowed: 10 minutes)

- a) Only Malayalam songs shall be allowed.
- b) The number of participants shall be 7. (Minimum 5)
- c) No Musical Instruments except Sruthi Box is allowed.

### 2. Patriotic Song (Time allowed: 10 minutes)

- a) Malayalam, Hindi or English songs shall be allowed.
- b) Song should be related to the theme of national integration.
- c) No other musical instrument except sruthi box is allowed.
- d) The number of participants shall be 7. (Minimum 5)

### 3. SKIT-ENGLISH (Time allowed: 15mts.)

- a) The play shall be based on any theme. Number of characters in the play should not exceed 10 persons. 3 persons are allowed for stage preparation. Only 5 mts is the time allowed for stage preparation.
- b) No major backdrops (stage settings) are allowed but the props that cannot be avoided for the character can be used. (Eg. when you depict a palace scene, no screen backdrops of the palace is needed but the props like crown, sword of the king can be used). Prior settings on the stage will not be permitted.
- c) Sound effects (only extra music effects) appropriate for the scene is allowed but the dialogue should be presented live. (No recording allowed for the dialogue.) Use of keyboard for background music is allowed. No light effects are allowed for the play.
- d) Any movable property which can be arranged within the allotted time for stage setting can be used on the stage. It can be kept only inside the curtain, and outside spaces cannot be used for the same.
- **4. GROUP DANCE:** Cinematic dance and Film songs are not allowed. Song should be from folk genre.
- Music recorded on USBs shall only be used for Group Dance. The USBs shall be handed over to the stage manager 10 minutes before the performance.



### 5. POWERPOINT PRESENTATION – (2 Participants)

### Time allowed: 1 hour for preparation and 5 minutes for presentation.

- e) Number of slides and the topic will be announced at the beginning of the event at the venue. No CD or pen drive is permitted, and internet should not be used.
- f) The file should be saved in the folder named Power Point Presentation created on the desktop. The participants have to confirm the folder and check that the file is saved in the specific folder before logging off. Organizers will not be responsible for any lost file.
- g) THE FILE NAME SHOULD BE COMPULSORILY PARTICIPANT'S CHEST NUMBER. ALL OTHER FILE NAMES WILL BE CONSIDERED AS INVALID ENTRY.
- h) The images needed for the slide will be provided in the folder named Power Point Presentation created on the desktop. Choose the appropriate images and backgrounds. Windows 2010 version will be provided in the computer.
- 6. OTTAMTHULLAL: back stages ingers can be non-students as well.
- 7. MIME: Music recorded in USB can only be used.
- The USBs shall be handed over to the stage manager 10 minutes before the performance.
- Music playing through mobile phones is not permitted.

### 8. DIGITAL PAINTING: (Time allowed: 30 mts.)

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- i) Image size in MS Paint should not exceed as given below.
  - Width = 10 inches, Height = 7 inches, Resolution = 102 x 81 dots per inches.
- j) The images should be created by the participants on the spot. No external images should be used.
- k) The file should be saved in JPEG file format. The file should be saved in the folder named Digital Painting created on the desktop.
- 1) THE FILE NAME SHOULD BE COMPULSORILY PARTICIPANT'S CHEST NUMBER. ALL OTHER FILE NAME WILL BE CONSIDERED AS INVALID ENTRY.
- m) Confirm the folder and check that your file is saved in the specific folder.

  Organizers will not be Responsible for any lost file.
- n) Text can be used to specify the theme, but the participants name or other



- details should not be mentioned on the images created.
- o) Theme will be announced by the judges and systems will be provided with MS paint 2010.

### 9. COLLAGE DESIGNING (Time allowed: 2hrs.)

- p) Waste magazine cuttings and newspapers can be used for collage designing. If needed, water colour can be used for designing.
- q) Size of the design will be based on the paper distributed at the time of competition. (A3 size paper)
- r) Only paper will be provided at the time of competition, all other materials necessary for the designing should be brought by the participants. Theme will be announced by the judges.

### 10. ANCHORING (Time allowed: 7mts)

- s) Theme will be given one hour before the competition. The participant should be able to speak continuously on the given theme. There should be no gap in between.
- t) The Subject matter will be based on any event which should be anchored completely (E.g.: Award meet, Film Show etc.)
- u) Presentation should only be in English using appropriate facial expressions and voice modulation.
- v) The participant can utilize the entire stage if necessary.

# 11. POSTER DESIGNING – (Time allowed : 2 hrs.)

- w) There should be one Logo or Emblem created by the participant based on the theme given. The poster design should be of commercial nature.
- x) Words or text is not compulsory while designing, but if wordings are used, it should be relevant to the theme.
- y) Size of the design will be based on the paper distributed at the time of competition.
- z) Themewillbeannouncedbythejudges. The participants can use any media for de signing (water colour, poster colour, fabric colour, crayons or colour pencil)
- aa) Cutting and pasting of pictures is not allowed. The design should be purely done by the participants themselves.
- bb) Only paper will be provided at the time of competition, all other materials necessary for the designing should be brought by the participants. (A3 size paper)



### ITEMS AND JUDGEMENT CRITERIA

### I. ART

### **Drawing, Painting and Cartoon. (Time Allowed: 2hrs)**

- a) The paper required will be provided to the participants.
- b) The theme or the topic will be given at the venue.
- c) The participants shall bring materials like, pen, pencil, colours. etc. Size of paper provided will be A3.

#### **VALUE POINTS:**

- **1. Drawing**: Proportion-shading-neatness-imagination and beauty of the strokes.
- **2. Painting**: Ability in doing portraits and scenery-Light and shade-imagination perception.
- **3.** Cartoon: Clarity of the theme —sense of humour- uniqueness-beauty of the strokes.

### II. LITERARY ITEMS

Essay writing, Story writing, Versification, Extempore, Elocution, Recitation.

#### VALUE POINTS:

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- 1. Essay writing: Suitable introduction and conclusion- systematic and logical arrangement of points, in-depth knowledge of the topic-flow of language- grammatical correctness, correct spelling.
- 2. Story writing: Correct understanding of the theme flow of language-correct Spelling.
- **3. Versification:** Rhythmic arrangement of words in poems -Imagination, flow of language, correct spelling.
- **4. Extempore/Elocution:** Time Limit, in-depth knowledge of the topic logical arrangement of points-flow of language-grammatical correctness, appropriate poise gestures-facial expressions- voice modulation-confidence.
- **5. Recitation:** Suitable facial expressions-imbibing the meaning and message of the poem- clarity and correct pronunciation- appropriate introduction and voice modulation. Only poems are allowed in recitation.



### III. MUSIC

- a. **Light Music**: Film Songs, album songs or devotional songs will not be allowed.
- b. ClassicalMusic: Sruthi can be used in classical music. Any 'raga' can be sung.
- c. **Instrumental Music**: Instrument should be arranged by the participants.
- d. **Mappilapattu**: Film songs are not allowed.

#### **VALUE POINTS**

- Light Music: Sangeetha Njanam Shareeram Sruthilayam-Njanabhavam – Shabda Shudhi – Thalam - Manodharmam
- **2.** Classical Music : Shareeram- Sruthilayam- Njanabhavam-Bhava Shudhi- Thalam Manodharmam.
- **3. Group Song**: Harmony Rhythm- Tune Njana bhavam-Group Singing, Sangeetha Njanam- sareeram- Sruthilayam- ShabdaShudhi-Thalam.
- 4. Thabala: Fingering, Chollu, Gamagam, Thalam,
- 5. Mrudangam: Fingering, Chollu, Nadam, Thalam
- 6. Violin (eastern): Fingering, Swarasthanam, Nadam, Thalam
- 7. Flute: Swarasthaanam, Thalam, Nadham, Manodharmam
- **8. Guitar**: Nadham, Thalam, fingering, Notation.
